I would like to explore the possibility of creating a Fish and Game Honor Guard. I have talked to Cal and he supports this possibility.

I'm looking for a few volunteers (no more than 1/region) to volunteer to be an exploratory committee. If you are interested, please contact your RCO.

By July 18th, please provide me your rep, if any, to be on this committee.

DCO's,

I would like one DCO to head up this committee and report back to me and the RCO's your findings sometime later this fall. Please let your RCO know if you are interested in taking on this challenge. RCO, please add your DCO of interest to your response by July 18th.

My charge and questions would be:

- **What does an Honor Guard do?**
- **How are they formed?**
- **How many officers are required? One rep from each region?**
- **What special training is required?**
- **What are their (honor guard) requirements and commitments?**
- **What would an appropriate IDFG Honor Guard uniform look like? I'm thinking that our basic uniform shirt with tie, new dress pant, crisp Stetson and add white gloves, a standard uniform Black Roper style boot and cover with a tunic/jacket, but an open to the findings of this committee. (see attached photos; in the CA pic, the center figure in front row is their Director)**
- **What additional costs would this incur?**
